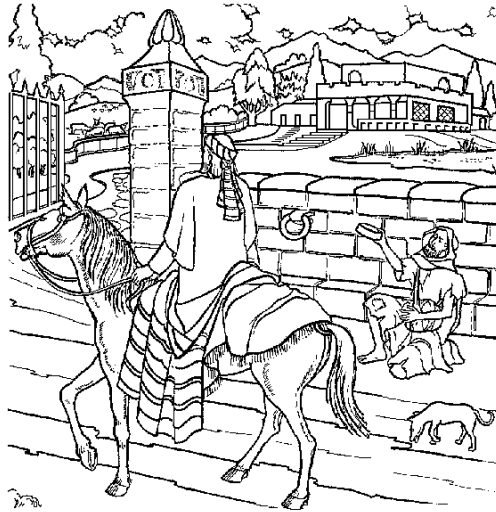


# THE RICH MAN & LAZARUS
